

Post Operative Instructions for Temporary Crown

You need to have a temporary crown on, even if your tooth is not sensitive without it. Your permanent crown will not fit properly if you go without your temporary for any length of time.

It is normal to have some sensitivity to hot & cold.

Sensodyne toothpaste may help with sensitivity.

If pain persists for more than a few days, Please call the office.

If temporary feels uncomfortable or feels too high (like your biting on it first), please call the office.

If the temporary crown comes off and you have a problem with cementing it with the temporary cement provided, please call the office.

How to cement the temporary.

Clean the old cement from the inside of the crown as best as your can with a toothpick.

Try the crown on to feel how it fits comfortably.

Mix part A & par B of the cement with a toothpick and lightly line the inside of the temporary crown, bite down to seat.

Wait about 1 minute for cement to dry, clean off with a toothbrush or tooth pick and floss. If you have any problems, please give us a call.

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
